

What to Expect During the Worship Service

Offering

• Offering baskets are located in front of the communion table and at each entrance. Or you may give online using the QR code.

Nursery

• Available in room 209 from 9:30 until 11:30am for ages 0 to 3.

Children's Message

• Children will be invited forward for the Children's Message. They will be dismissed to the Nursery, Cherub Class or Children's Church right after the message. The children will return in time to take communion with their families.

Middle and High School Students

• Middle and High School Students are invited to participate in a special Christian education time just for them in the youth room immediately following the Children's Message.

Communion

- The usher will indicate when it is time to come forward to receive the communion elements.
- When you approach, the pastor will hand you a piece of bread which you then dip into the juice. Please be sure to not let your fingers touch the juice.
- Prepackaged elements are available for those who would prefer not to receive communion from the pastors. Please throw away the packing in a trash receptacle, available at the exits.
- Gluten free communion elements are available from the communion stewards standing on the right side, in front of the pulpit.
- You may kneel for prayer at the chancel rail if you like.
